

Cursive Practice: Tricky Connections

Most lowercase letters start and end at the midline, so they are easy to connect.

Example:

sailing



Some lowercase letters (b, o, v, w) end at the midline and can be more challenging to connect. These letters alters the way the next letter starts, because they need to both join at the midline.

Example:

novel
